Top cities for international association meetings in 2016: Type A

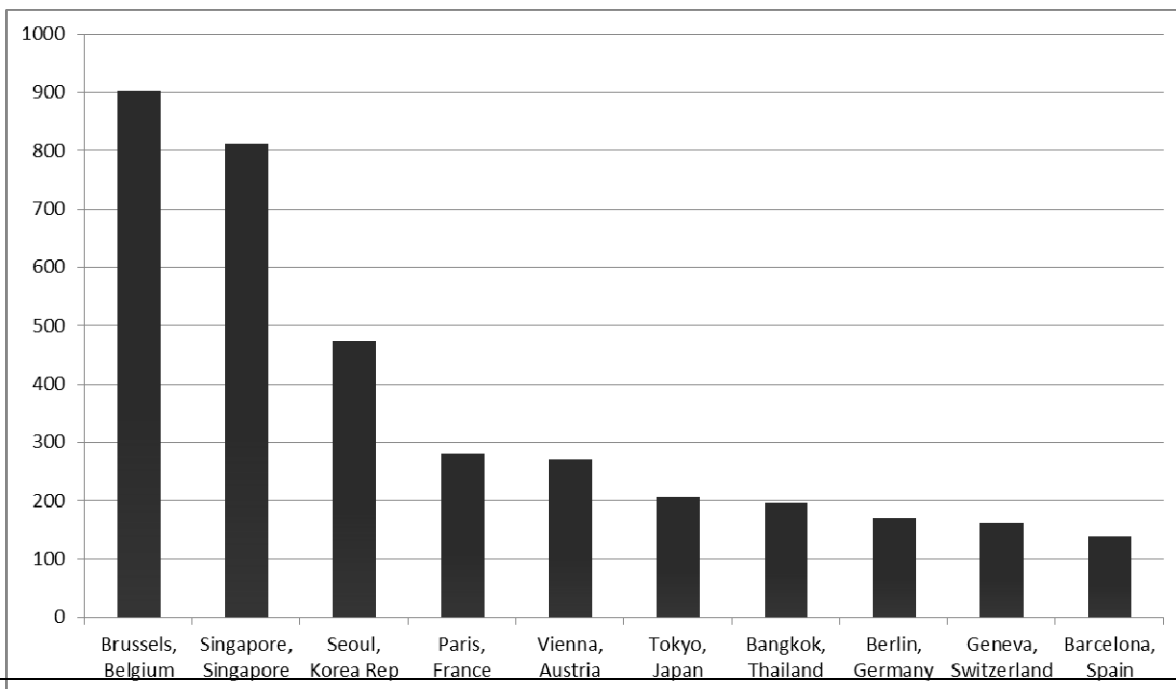
